Since a long time, the Corporation of the City of Panaji wanted to setup a comprehensive mapping and data resource for citizens of Panaji and Students and Researchers who wish to access data on the city that relates to key parameters and statistics of the city.

In this context, the Corporation recently appointed the Charles Correa Foundation to develop the archives and create a repository of information on the city of Panaji at the Foundation. This involves detailed mapping of the city, assimilating information from various sources that contribute to the city including planning authorities and other government and non-government agencies and stakeholders in the city.

This information – once built will be updated quarterly: once every three months and will be available from the Charles Correa Foundation. The Panaji Archives will also help citizens to know more about the city through old maps and photographs that will be assimilated by the Foundation.

Charles Correa Foundation has already started work on building the base maps and will soon create a GIS system for data. The corporation is committed to empower the citizens of Panaji through information within this initiative led by the Charles Correa Foundation.
